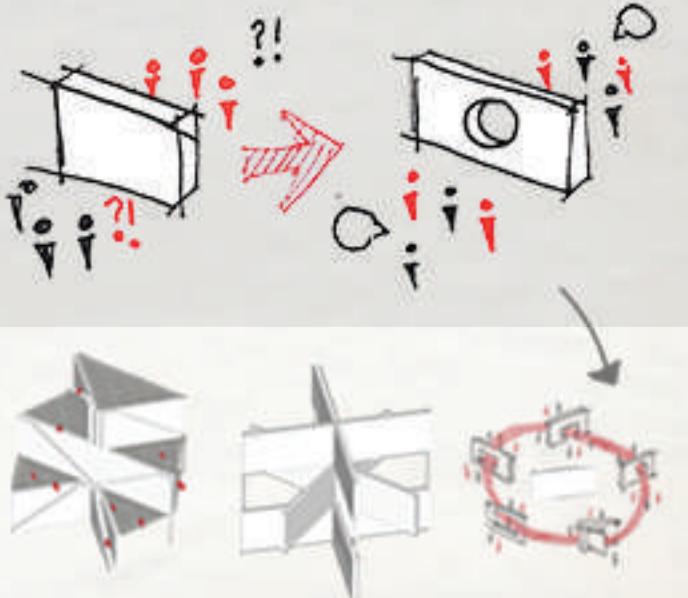
ANALYSIS

BUILDING CONCEPT

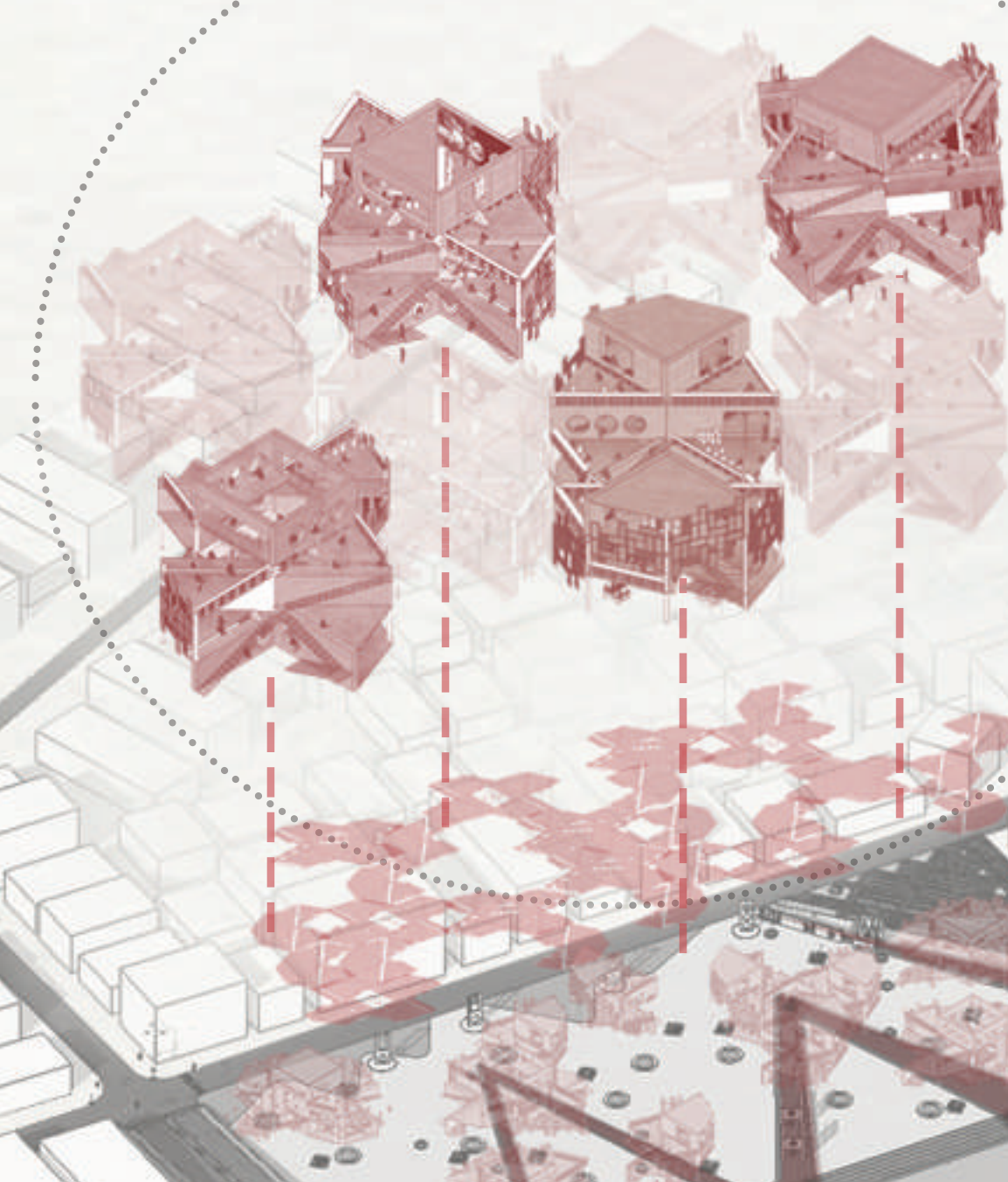


HOMELESS CHILDREN are unique and creative individuals. Most of the time these homeless children are based in the city center, however, they are often marginalized from the limelight. The homeless children need to be given the opportunity and the choice to improve their potential. The street corners of Banjarmasin are not the ideal home for these children.

THE CITY has become a place for homeless children to live, but still, it is not a home for them. Anak Jalanan (homeless children), who have high mobility in doing their activities, is having their privacy spaces in public areas. They have the ability to create their own temporary spaces in doing their activities which is highly flexible.

THE YOUTH DEVELOPMENT CENTER is the place to develop the potential of homeless children through creative fields with a sense of home in the design. It will be the hub for these children to express themselves through their creations and receive the opportunity to learn more without the space restriction.

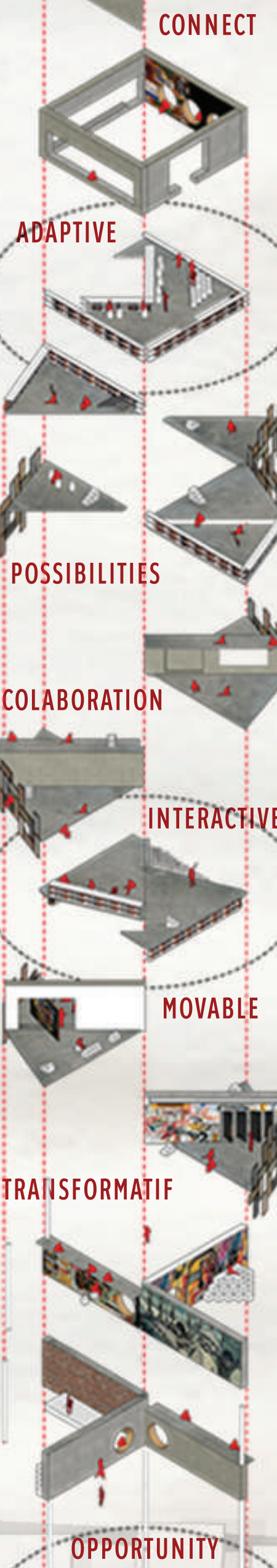
